## Sentence Patterns

### i. Beginning

I want to go to the USA for \_\_\_\_\_.  
I will arrive / leave / return on [date].

*Students must be confident with dates, and give a date of departure (leaving) or returning to Taiwan that is later than their date of arrival.*

I will return to Taiwan for \_\_\_\_\_. (No interrogation at beginner level)

*It is a good idea for countries outside the USA to practice writing the date in DD/MM/YY format and MM/DD/YY format.*

### ii. Intermediate

I want to go to the USA for \_\_\_\_\_.

I will study \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ (in USA).

I will arrive/leave/return to/from the USA /Taiwan on \_\_\_\_\_.

I will do \_\_\_\_\_ business in Taiwan

I want to go to visit \_\_\_\_\_.  
I will meet \_\_\_\_\_. I will also help my little cousin study Chinese.  
I will arrive on \_\_\_\_\_.

## Situation E – Visiting Family

*Advanced Level: students must prove their intention to return to Taiwan. If the student's English is at high level, the instructor may choose to change the dialogue to further "interrogate" the student, so that it could be more challenging.*

O: Officer

S: Student

O. Hello. Why do you want to go to the US?

S. I want to go to visit my Uncle and Aunt and cousins.

O. What will you do while you are there?

S. I will meet my family. I will also help my little cousin study Chinese.

O. When will you arrive in the US?

S. I will arrive on \_\_\_\_\_.

O. When will you leave the US?

S. I will leave on \_\_\_\_\_.

O. Will you return to Taiwan?

S. Yes, I will return to Taiwan after I visit my family.

O. What if you like the US and want to stay with your Uncle and Aunt instead of living in Taiwan?

S. My parents live in Taiwan. If I stay in the US, I will miss them. And I must go to the university in Taipei next year.

O. Do you have a return ticket?

S. Yes, here it is.

*Notes to instructor:*

*Please interrogate the student to as great a degree as possible, based on their language ability. The student should feel challenged but not feel uncomfortable or embarrassed in front of their fellow students.*
